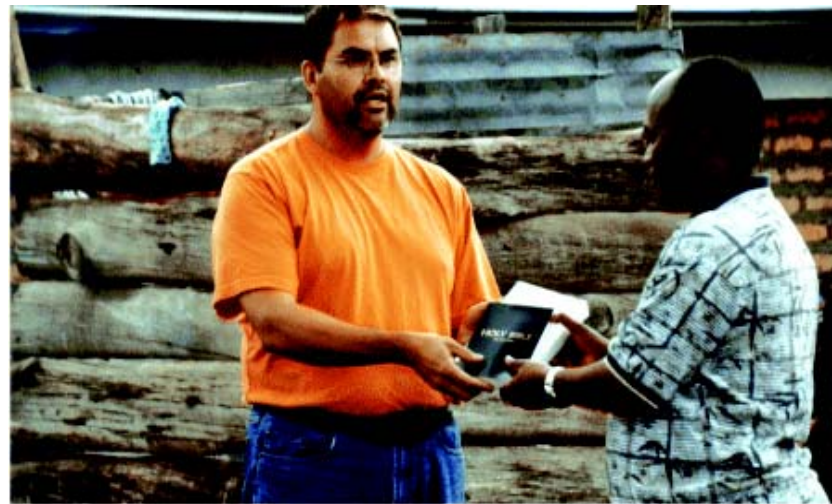


## Various Ways of Presenting Bibles and Bible Pathways to Others

A multi-denominational group from Louisville, KY, they have sponsored 11 orphanages in Kenya. On their recent mission trip the group carried in two suitcases full of *Bibles* and *The Best of Bible Pathways* for 10 staff members and the 78 orphans, many of whom have HIV/AIDS in Rongo. The staff was very excited since it was the first time all the students had identical *Bibles* and *Bible* devotional study books. At a cost of \$125 each for a 50 lb. suitcase full of the precious Word of God, the group was able to carry extra suitcases along with the luggage, a cost much cheaper than sending them via post. Mike said that the pastors from the Amani Orphanage came to him with a delegation asking if the group would bring *Bibles* and *Bible Pathways* for their students when they returned next year. Incidentally, Mike apologized for looking rather “rough” in the photo. HIV/AIDS is so prevalent none of the men in the missionary group were allowed to shave for fear of cutting themselves and being exposed to the dreaded disease.

## God Multiplies Your Gifts Like the Miracle of the Loaves & the Fish (Matthew 14)

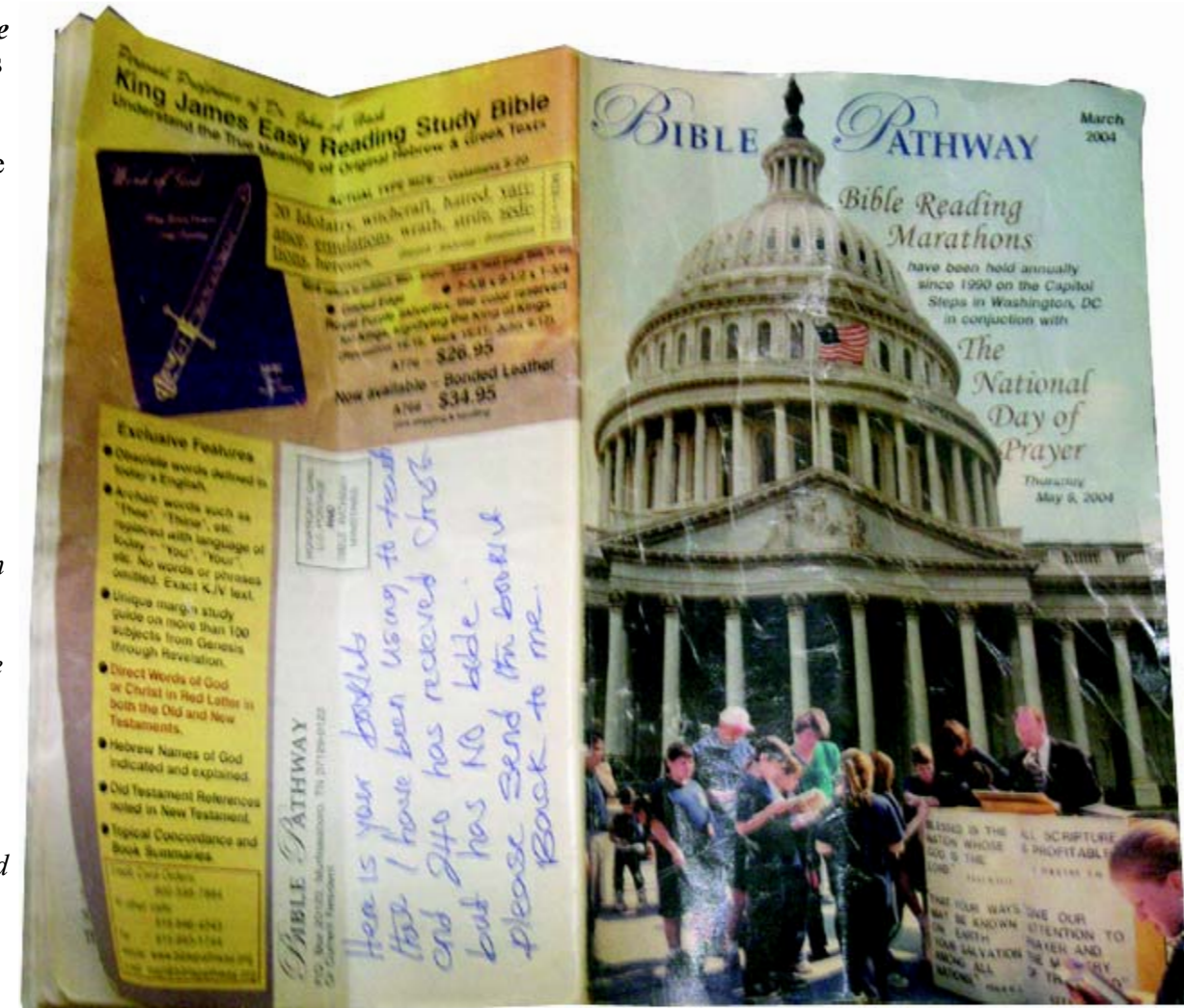

*May God continue to bless you every day. Please I am begging you to send Bible*

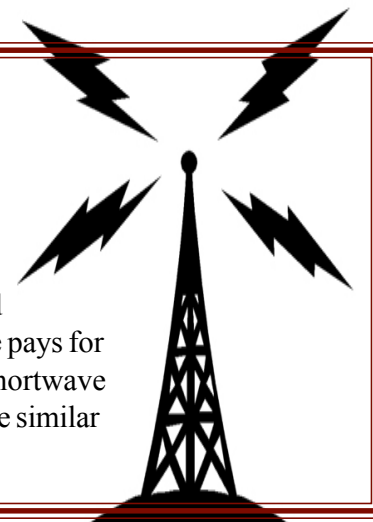

## Look What the Lord Has Done!

Pictured above is the means the Lord used to accomplish His will to the Navajo Indians located just outside of Flagstaff, AZ. I was having trouble sleeping one night so I decided to read some mail. The "Widow's Mite" newsletter caught my attention. Betsy Frazier, missionary to the Navajo Indians, was asking for both Navajo and English Bibles, Bible Pathways, and a number of other items to be distributed on the reservation. Her description of the many needs of the native American families touched my heart.

Bible Pathway staff prayed about supplying Navajo Bibles, which are very expensive. Within a few days the staff had collected sufficient funds to purchase the Bibles requested. As word spread many items came in and we had a full truckload, but the shipping cost was tremendous.

Since Bible Pathway Ministries depends entirely on the freewill offerings of our readers and supporters, most of the funds we receive are designated for certain outreaches. There was no way we could come up with the extra funds to ship the Bibles and other things. An "URGENT" request was put on our website for a volunteer to take the Bibles, etc., to Flagstaff. The person would need a truck or van.

Mission Network News Christian Radio ran an interview. Within an hour of the broadcast, calls began coming in. One person offered to take it but wasn't free to travel for another four weeks. Then, two ladies in Arkansas heard the broadcast and called a man in their church whose neighbor was a trucker – Ken Peacock, in Springdale, AR. Ken knew of a man with Covenant Transport in Chattanooga, TN. The man at Covenant Transportation knew a man at Great Southern in Tunnel Hill, GA – J.R. Banter. Mr. Banter called and arranged for the truck to come to Pathway headquarters in Murfreesboro, TN, pick up the load, and deliver it to Flagstaff. A sister group in Flagstaff was contacted and David Gerhard of Read Aloud Ministries, arranged to receive the shipment and transport it to the Reservation via local transportation. An extra pallet of Bibles and Bible Pathways went to Read Aloud Ministries for their local ministry.

Only the Lord could have arranged this. Join us in praying that many souls will find Jesus as their Lord and Savior through this magnificent outreach.
